Winter Hiking in the Tannheimer Tal

Winter hiking is a wonderful way to experience the snow-covered landscape of the Tannheimer Tal. Around 81 kilometres of cleared winter hiking trails lead through the fairytale scenery, with cosy huts along the way inviting walkers to stop for a warming drink or a traditional snack. A detailed cross-country skiing and winter hiking map is available from the tourist information offices for €3.00.

Winter Hiking in the Mountains

Winterwandern auf der Höh' (Winter Hiking at Altitude)

The approximately 2.2-kilometre route around Neunerköpfle is mostly flat and, weather and snow conditions permitting, is prepared daily. It lies at an altitude of almost 1,900 metres. From the Neunerköpfle mountain station, the trail leads through the Tannheimer mountain landscape with magnificent panoramic views. Highlights along the route include the largest summit book in the Alps, the impressive Neunerköpfle summit cross and several photo points. Wonderful views across the Tannheimer Tal, the Allgäu Alps and the neighbouring Allgäu region are guaranteed.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min | **Distance:** approx. 2.2 km

Panoramainformator und Sonnenhut auf dem Gamskopf (Panoramic Information Display and Sonnenhut on Gamskopf)

Zugspitze, Ortler and Piz Buin – famous mountains that can all be seen from the Tannheimer Tal with the help of the panoramic information display. It stands beside the summit cross on the 1,890-metre-high Gamskopf near Grän and, in good weather, offers views of more than 100 kilometres across the surrounding mountain landscape. The route to the information display passes the Sonnenpanoramahut. At an altitude of 1,850 metres stands the largest rotating hiking hat in the Alps. In winter too, visitors can sit and enjoy the magnificent views, provided snow conditions allow. This easy hike is also suitable for children and older visitors. The route starts at the mountain station of the Füssener Jöchle gondola and leads to the summit of Gamskopf.

Walking time: approx. 40 min · **Distance:** approx. 1 km

Schattwald

Schattwald – Unterjoch

From the car park below the municipal office, head towards the church. From there, continue west through the Kappl district along the Vils. Cross the Vils at the bridge and follow Rehbachstraße to the Unterjoch junction. Turn left and continue along the path via the Steineberg district to Unterjoch. The return journey can be made along the same route or via Krummenbach back to Schattwald.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs 45 min · **Distance:** approx. 11 km

Schattwald – Rehbach

From the car park below the municipal office, head towards the church. From there, continue west through the Kappl district. Cross the bridge, pass the petrol station and continue through the Steig

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district along Rehbachstraße to Rehbach. A stop for drinks is possible at Hotel Rehbach; no food is served. Return along the same route.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs 15 min · **Distance:** approx. 8.5 km

Schattwald – Zöblen – Schattwald

The winter hike begins at the Schattwald Dorfplatz bus stop. From there, head towards the church. At the church, turn right and continue through the snow-covered Fricken district. The cleared winter hiking trail then leads on to Zöblen and its church. Around 50 metres further east, turn right behind Hotel Alpenrose, cross the main road and follow the path running parallel to it towards the edge of the village and back onto the route to Fricken. Shortly after the Zöblen village sign, turn left onto the path along the wintry Vils and return to the starting point in Schattwald.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr · **Distance:** approx. 4.3 km

Zöblen

Zöblen – Zugspitzblick

From the car park at the western entrance to the village, head north through Zöblen, keeping left at the junctions, and cross the bridge. Continue past a handful of houses in Untere Halde and follow the asphalted path in several bends up to Gasthaus Zugspitzblick at 1,300 metres on Obere Halde.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 4.3 km

Zöblen über den Höhenweg nach Tannheim (Zöblen via the High-Level Trail to Tannheim)

From the car park at the western entrance to the village, head north through Zöblen and turn right before the bridge, continuing east. Follow the high-level trail to the Kienzerle district, passing the campsite on the right. Then turn left and continue east, parallel to the small stream, until just before the main road. Continue east parallel to the Vils and Berger Ache towards Tannheim. Return by bus, route 120, towards Oberjoch.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr · **Distance:** approx. 4 km

Zöblen – Tannheim – Zöblen

The starting point is the West car park in Zöblen. The route initially runs parallel to the main road, then continues through the wintry Zöbler Moos towards Tannheim. At the end of the path, turn left uphill towards the campsite. At the lower side of the campsite, turn right and cross a small pedestrian bridge. The cleared winter hiking trail continues through the snow-covered Untergschwend district to St Leonhard Chapel. From here, continue to Kienzen and then follow the municipal road towards the church. After the underpass, the route leads through the wintry Berg district and continues to the campsite. Finally, turn right onto the high-level trail and follow it back to Zöblen.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 8.7 km

Tannheim

Naturschutzgebiet Vilsalpsee (Vilsalpsee Nature Reserve)

The Vilsalpsee (Lake) Nature Reserve is one of the special treasures of our region. It is home to numerous animals and plants, many of them rare and protected, and offers a natural paradise with picturesque scenery.

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Useful information:

- Walking all the way around Vilsalpsee (Lake) is not possible in winter due to avalanche danger.
- Walking on the frozen lake is not permitted.
- Due to water movement at the power station, the lake never freezes over completely.

The tour starts at the tourist information office in Tannheim and follows the cleared road directly to Vilsalpsee (Lake).

Walking time: approx. 1 hr · **Distance:** approx. 4 km

Tannheim – Haldensee (Lake) – Haller

From the Berg car park in Tannheim, the winter hiking trail first leads through Innergschwend, past the Nepomuk Chapel and on to Grän. At Hotel Engel, bear slightly right onto Angerweg. Continue past the primary school via Waldwinkel and follow the signs towards Haldensee (Lake). Walk along the lakeshore to Haller. If the lake is frozen and officially open, it is also possible to walk across Haldensee (Lake) to Haller. Please always observe the signs. Return to Tannheim by hiking bus 120 towards Oberjoch.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 45 min · **Distance:** approx. 6.5 km

Tannheim – oberer Höhenweg (Tannheim – Upper High-Level Trail)

The tour starts at the Berg car park and leads north through the Berg district to the Schäferhütte. From there, turn right and then take the next opportunity to turn right again. At the following junction, turn right once more, now heading towards Innergschwend. The route completes the circuit and leads back to the starting point. A beautiful winter walk combining crisp mountain air with wide-ranging views.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr · **Distance:** approx. 4.4 km

Grän-Haldensee

Wiesenrundweg – große Runde (Meadow Circular Trail – Long Route)

The hike begins at the car park by the municipal office and initially leads north towards the church. After the church, continue along Dorfstraße to the main road. Follow the pavement along the snow-covered road as far as Zitt Transporte. Behind the company building, turn left onto Wiesenweg. Follow the signs as the route curves gently towards the bridge. After crossing the bridge, continue through the peaceful winter landscape back to Grän and the starting point.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 5 km

Gräner Waldweg (Grän Forest Trail)

This winter hike begins at the car park below the Grän municipal office. The route initially leads north through the village towards the church. Below the church, continue to the main road. Follow the road for around 200 metres and, after the bridge, turn right. The prepared forest road climbs steadily until it ends in a dead end. Return to the starting point along the same route.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs 15 min · **Distance:** approx. 5.2 km

Grän – Tannheim – Grän

The winter hiking trail starts at the car park by the municipal office and first leads past the medical centre before turning left towards Tannheim. Continue along Hubertusweg through the crisp winter air. At the end of the path, turn left and head west towards the Innergschwend district. The farms and houses lie peacefully in the wintry landscape. After the bridge, take the first turn on the left to

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reach Tannheim. Return to Grän along the same well-maintained winter trail – a circular walk combining winter atmosphere with wide-ranging views.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs · **Distance:** approx. 8 km

Nesselwängle

Nesselwängle – Haller

The winter hike starts at the car park by the sports centre in Nesselwängle and initially leads a short distance north before crossing beneath the main road through an underpass. From there, the route passes the bus stop and continues west. The cleared path runs above the main road, through a landscape of snow-covered fir trees and white meadows. Passing the peaceful Dreikreuzkapelle, the trail continues through the quiet valley to Haller. Return along the same route.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 5 km

Nesselwängle – Adlerhorst – Nesselwängle

The cleared winter hiking trail starts at the lift car park in Nesselwängle near Gasthof Schuster. After crossing a small stream, the route climbs to the left towards the Kletterwald. It then descends again, offering the first views of Haldensee (Lake). The trail winds down to a junction, where it turns right and follows the shore of Haldensee (Lake) to Haller. At Haldensee hotel, continue to the chapel in the village and then follow the signs towards Adlerhorst. The forest road leads pleasantly uphill to the mountain hut, offering magnificent views over Haldensee (Lake). Return along the same route to Haller. From there, continue across wide, snow-covered meadows towards Nesselwängle, passing the Dreikreuzkapelle and following the main road. Turn left again towards Nesselwängle and continue parallel to the main road as far as the bus stop. The underpass leads back to the starting point.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 7 km

Nesselwängle – Rauth

From the lift car park in Nesselwängle, follow the route east, running parallel to the main road and keeping right towards the Rauth district. For the return journey, either take the same route or turn right at the underpass and continue back to Nesselwängle.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 6.7 km

Nesselwängle – Krinnenalpe

From the lift car park in Nesselwängle, follow the prepared road up to Krinnenalpe. Return along the same route.

Walking time: approx. 4 hrs · **Distance:** approx. 8 km

Jungholz

Jungholzer Rundweg (Jungholz Circular Trail)

From the village centre, follow the road towards Pfeiffermühle as far as the edge of the village, then turn left towards Sorgalpe. After around 300 metres, turn right and continue to the main road. Cross it and follow the route above the Wertach to the campsite in the Habsbichl district.

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Continue to the inn, cross the road there and head towards the swimming pool. From there, either continue back to the village centre or turn left and follow the signs towards Gießenschwand.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 4.5 km

Höhenweg (Panorama Trail)

From the village centre, follow the Mühlbach stream towards the Langenschwand district. Cross the road and continue along the access road to the high-level trail. The route then leads high above Jungholz, gently downhill past the moor pond into the Gießenschwand district and back to the village centre along the road.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 6.7 km

Jungholz – Alpe Stubental

From the car park by the ski lifts, head towards the church. At the music pavilion, turn right and follow the road to the Langenschwand district and continue to the end of the village.

Here, the route branches off to the left towards Alpe Stubental. After stopping for refreshments, return to Langenschwand or Jungholz either on foot or by toboggan, which can be hired at the hut.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr · **Distance:** approx. 3 km

Schneeschuhwandern (Snowshoe Hiking)

More and more hikers are discovering snowshoeing as a gentle way to experience the winter landscape up close, without the pressure of sporting performance. Guided snowshoe hikes with local hiking guides are offered every week. They know some of the most beautiful places throughout the region. Further information is available from all tourist information offices.

Grän – Adlerhorst

The snowshoe hike initially starts without snowshoes at the car park below the municipal office. Continue towards the church and past it to Restaurant Burgschenke. Below the restaurant, follow the path through the snow-covered forest to Berggasthof Adlerhorst. Return along the same route or continue down to Haller.

Walking time: approx. 1 hr · **Distance:** approx. 2.4 km · **Ascent | Descent:** approx. 222 | 49 m

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Tannheim über das Lohmoos nach Zöblen (Tannheim via Lohmoos to Zöblen)

The hike starts at the car park by the underpass in Tannheim towards the Berg district. Head east through Berg, with the Einstein mountain always in view, as the trail gradually climbs. Follow the signs towards Lohmoos and continue along the access road through the beautiful winter landscape to the small plateau of Lohmoos. At the junction, follow the route towards Gasthof Zugspitzblick. From there, continue along the road down to the village square in Zöblen.

Walking time: approx. 2 hrs 30 min · **Distance:** approx. 9 km · **Ascent | Descent:** approx. 380 | 396 m
